**A PROPOSAL UNDER THE *MARINE PARKS ACT 2004* AND A BRIEF
EXPLANATION OF THE PROPOSAL**

- (A) A Proposal, under section 9 of the *Marine Parks Act 2004*, requesting the Governor in Council to make a revocation by regulation of the declaration as marine park, of:
- (i) part of the Great Sandy Marine Park, described as Unallocated State Land within the Burrum River and containing an area of 2.2 hectares of tidal lands and tidal waters as illustrated on the attached sketch.
- (B) A brief explanation of the Proposal.
- (i) The proposed revocation of an area of 2.2 hectares of tidal lands and tidal waters from the Great Sandy Marine Park within the Burrum River adjacent to Lions Park (Lot 5 on CP880110) at Burrum Heads.

The area is sought to be used for the development of a public boat ramp and associated car-trailer parking area.
