An Act authorising the Treasurer to pay amounts from the consolidated fund for the Legislative Assembly and parliamentary service for the financial years starting 1 July 2015 and 1 July 2016

The Parliament of Queensland enacts— 1

1 Short title 2

This Act may be cited as the *Appropriation (Parliament) Act 2015*. 3

2 Appropriation for 2015–2016 10

(1) The Treasurer is authorised to pay \$87,274,000 from the 11
consolidated fund for the Legislative Assembly and 12
parliamentary service for the financial year starting 1 July 13
2015. 14

(2) The amount mentioned in subsection (1) is appropriated for 15
the financial year for the Legislative Assembly and 16
parliamentary service for application to its departmental 17
services, equity adjustment and administered items as stated 18
in schedule 1. 19

(3) The amount mentioned in subsection (1) includes the amount 20
already authorised by the *Appropriation (Parliament) Act 21*
2014, section 3, to be paid for the financial year starting 1 July 22
2015. 23

3 Supply for 2016–2017 24

The Treasurer is authorised to pay \$43,637,000 from the 25
consolidated fund for the Legislative Assembly and 26
parliamentary service for the financial year starting 1 July 27
2016. 28
