1 Introduction

1.1 Role of the Committee

The Agriculture and Environment Committee is a portfolio committee established by the Legislative Assembly on 27 March 2015 under the *Parliament of Queensland Act 2001*.¹ It consists of government and non-government members. The committee's primary areas of responsibility are: agriculture and fisheries; sport and racing; environment and heritage protection; and national parks and the Great Barrier Reef.²

Section 93(1) of the *Parliament of Queensland Act 2001* provides that a portfolio committee is responsible for examining each Bill and item of subordinate legislation in its portfolio area to consider –

- a) the policy to be given effect by the legislation
- b) the application of fundamental legislative principles to the legislation, and
- c) for subordinate legislation its lawfulness.

1.2 Aim of this report

This report advises of portfolio subordinate legislation tabled between 27 March 2015 and 5 May 2015 (listed below) that the committee has examined. All the items of subordinate legislation covered by this report were tabled on 5 May 2015 and have a disallowance date of 16 September 2015. No FLP or policy issues were identified by the committee.
