1 Aim of this report

The policy objective of this amendment regulation was to facilitate the 2018 Townsville 400 V8 motor racing event which was held from 6 to 8 July 2018 by prescribing the 2018 Townsville 400 as a major event under the *Major Events Act 2014*.

The committee was satisfied that the subordinate legislation did not raise any significant issues relating to policy, fundamental legislative principles or lawfulness, and that the explanatory notes complied with part 4 of the *Legislative Standards Act 1992*.
