

## Legal Affairs and Community Safety Committee

### Subordinate legislation tabled between 9 August 2017 and 5 September 2017 Report No. 2, 56<sup>th</sup> Parliament

#### 1 Aim of this report

This report summarises the committee’s findings following its examination of the subordinate legislation within its portfolio areas tabled between 9 August 2017 and 5 September 2017. It reports on any issues identified by the committee relating to the policy to be given effect by the legislation, fundamental legislative principles and lawfulness. It also reports on the compliance of the explanatory notes with the *Legislative Standards Act 1992*.
