



**Erratum to Report No. 16, 57<sup>th</sup> Parliament – Subordinate legislation tabled  
between 16 June 2021 and 31 August 2021**

The Economics and Governance Committee would like to correct an error and clarify a comment in the committee's *Report No. 16, 57<sup>th</sup> Parliament – Subordinate legislation tabled between 16 June 2021 and 31 August 2021*, tabled on 25 October 2021.

On page 17, in the table set out in Appendix B, the date of the tabling of the Minister's report on the Building Fire Safety Regulation 2008, made under section 56A(4) of the *Statutory Instruments Act 1992*, is incorrectly identified as '15 October 2021', and the Minister's complete title is not listed. The report was tabled in the Parliament on 25 November 2021 by the Minister for Police and Corrective Services and Minister for Fire and Emergency Services.

On page 9 of the report, the committee noted that the various reports of Ministers in relation to subordinate legislation to be further exempted from expiry under section 56A of the *Statutory Instruments Act 1992* were 'tabled as required'. While all reports were indeed tabled, neither the report on the Building Fire Safety Regulation 2008 mentioned above, nor the report on the State Buildings Protective Security Regulation 2008 (tabled on 15 October 2021) were tabled within 7 sitting days of those extension regulations being made, as is required under section 56A(4). The committee notes that section 56A(5) also provides that a failure to comply with the specified timeframe of 7 sitting days 'does not affect the validity of the extension regulation'.
