Brisbane Olympic and Paralympic Games Arrangements Amendment Bill 2024

QUEENSLAND GOVERNMENT RESPONSE

INTRODUCTION

On 17 April 2024, the Brisbane Olympic and Paralympic Games Arrangements Amendment Bill 2024 (the Bill) was introduced into the Queensland Parliament by the Minister for State Development and Infrastructure, Minister for Industrial Relations and Minister for Racing. The Bill was declared urgent and referred to the Housing, Big Build and Manufacturing Committee (the Committee) for examination and report by 17 May 2024.

On 17 May 2024, the Committee tabled in Parliament Report No. 9 into the Bill (the Report).

The Queensland Government response to the recommendations contained in the Report is provided below.

RESPONSE TO RECOMMENDATIONS

Recommendation 1

The Committee recommends that the Bill Olympic and Paralympic Games Arrangements Amendment Bill 2024 be passed.
