## Dear Ms Cawcutt

Thank you for your letter dated 20 August 2013, regarding the Question on Notice taken at the Health and Community Services Committee public hearing on 7 August 2013 in relation to the implementation and recommendations in the Auditor-General's Report to Parliament 4: 2012-3, Queensland Health – eHealth Program.

I thank the Member for Bundamba for the question of 'whether there are any officers or consultants who worked on the Health payroll working on the eHealth project, including HBCIS, and if so, what level they are".

Apart from the Chief Information Officer being involved in the governance processes I can advise that there are no Queensland Health staff and/or Contractors/Consultants who were associated with the payroll implementation project currently working within the eHealth Program, including HBCIS.

I further advise that there are five staff and one Consultant currently working on the eHealth Program who worked as part of the payroll recovery team post go-live. These staff comprise of 1x AO3, 2 x AO4, 1x AO5, 1x AO8 and one Business Change Consultant.
