I refer to the Legal Affairs and Community Safety Committee's Report No. 80, Weapons (Digital 3D and Printed Firearms) Amendment Bill 2014, which was tabled on 7 November 2014.

Under section 107 of the *Parliament of Queensland Act 2001*, a response to the Committee's report is due three months after tabling. As the Legislative Assembly was dissolved on 6 January 2015 and the Government is now operating under caretaker conventions, it is not possible to provide a substantive response at this time.

Therefore, in accordance with section 59A of the *Parliament of Queensland Act 2001*, and Standing Order 31, I request that this document be tabled as an interim response to the report during the period that the Legislative Assembly is dissolved.
