RE: QUESTIONS ON NOTICE - SERIOUS AND ORGANISED CRIME  
LEGISLATION AMENDMENT BILL 2016

We refer to the conference of 4 October 2016 held by the Committee regarding the *Serious and Organised Crime Legislation Amendment Bill* ("the Bill").

We confirm that our Michael Kosenko appeared before the Committee and made submissions on behalf of the United Motorcycle Council Queensland ("UMCQ"). We are advised the committee placed the UMCQ on notice to provide the following information:

1. The UMCQ has approximately 1,570 members;
2. Members are required to pay an annual membership fee of \$58.00;
3. At the time of the infamous Broadbeach incident, the UMCQ did have some members who were present at the time;
4. The UMCQ is aware that many people who attended the Broadbeach incident were not UMCQ members and were from interstate; and
5. The UMCQ does not condone or excuse like behaviour in any form by its members.
