

**NOTICE OF MINISTERIAL DESIGNATION OF LAND
FOR COMMUNITY INFRASTRUCTURE
UNDER THE *SUSTAINABLE PLANNING ACT 2009***

A Ministerial Designation has been made

I, Cameron Dick MP, Minister for Health, give notice that under the *Sustainable Planning Act 2009*, chapter 5, I made a Ministerial designation of land for community infrastructure on 12 June 2015.

Description of the land to which the designation applies

The Ministerial designation applies to land located at 289 Nicklin Way, Warana.

The land is described as Parish of Mooloolah, County of Canning, Lot 6 on Crown Plan W9554.

Type of community infrastructure for which the land has been designated

The land has been designated for the Warana Peer Support Facility, which will provide peer support facility providing individual and group peer support programs and peer telephone support service.

This community infrastructure is described under the *Sustainable Planning Regulation 2009*, Schedule 2 as –

- (4) community and cultural facilities, including facilities where an education and care service under the Education and Care Services National Law (Queensland) is operated or a QEC approved service under the *Education and Care Services Act 2013* is operated, community centres, meeting halls, galleries and libraries; and
- (16) any other facility not mentioned in this part that is intended primarily to accommodate government functions.
