1. Short title

This university statute may be cited as the *University of Queensland Election of Elected Members of Senate Statute 2015*.

2. Application

- (1) This statute is about the conduct of a ballot for the election of elected members of senate and other matters mentioned in section 15 of the *University of Queensland Act 1998*.
- (2) This statute does not apply when senate appoints a candidate to a casual vacancy in accordance with section 20A(2) of the Act.

3. Election of elected members of senate

- (1) The elected members of senate are chosen by ballots held under section 15(3) of the Act on the dates decided by the senate.
- (2) A member of the part-time academic staff may vote for the elected member referred to section 15(2)(b) of the Act only if he or she is employed under a contract with a term of employment of 6 months or more requiring at least 18 hours of work each week.
- (3) A member of the part-time general staff may vote for the elected member referred to in section 15(2)(c) of the Act only if he or she is employed under a contract with a term of employment of 6 months or more requiring at least 18 hours of work each week.
- (4) All graduates may vote for the elected members referred to in section 15(2)(f) of the Act.

(5) Where a person is a member of more than one category mentioned in section 15(2) of the Act, the person may only stand for election in one category at any one election.

4. Repeal

The following statutes are repealed –

- (a) University of Queensland Statute No. 1 (Election of Elected Members of Senate) 2005; and
- (b) University of Queensland (Making and Notifying University Rules) Statute 2008.
