I refer to a petition number 2397-15 lodged with the Legislative Assembly by Mr Linus Power MP, Member for Logan on 1 December 2015 about restoring bus services in Logan.

Following my appointment as Minister for Transport and the Commonwealth Games, I am the responsible minister to answer this question.

I understand that changes to bus routes in Logan were implemented in January 2014 as part of the South East Queensland bus network review conducted by the Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR). These changes were based on TMR's analysis of route performance and input from affected communities over an extended consultation period.

I wish to assure you, TMR will continue to monitor the performance of bus routes and demand for services in the area to ensure they are providing an efficient and reliable service that meets the needs of the broader community.
