MR HAYWARD asked the Minister for Environment, Local Government, Planning and Women (MS DESLEY BOYLE)–

QUESTION:

What grants and subsidies have been received by the Caboolture and Pine Shire Councils during the last year?

ANSWER:

(1) Caboolture Shire Council has been approved a total of \$7,162,977.97 funding for 12 new projects under my Local Government and Planning portfolio and has received payment of \$6,597,865.42 for both new and previously approved projects, as outlined in Attachment A.

(2) Pine Rivers Shire Council has been approved a total of \$4,279,492.86 funding for 8 new projects under my Local Government and Planning portfolio and has received payment of \$4,325,032.27 for both new and previously approved projects, as outlined in Attachment B.
