MRS STUCKEY asked the Minister for Public Works and Information and Communication Technology (MR SCHWARTEN)-

QUESTION:

With reference to T.F. Woollam & Son, J.M. Kelly (Project Builders) and Carmichael Builders –

How many contracts have been awarded to, and tenders received from, these companies between 1 January 2004 and 5 October 2009 (reported separately and listing the nature of the contracts, completion costs, tendered costs and final costs)?

ANSWER:

The following table is the record of the total Government tenders received, as recorded in the Department of Public Works' Prequalification System (PQC) from the above three nominated companies, broken down into accepted, not accepted and not yet evaluated categories by number and tendered value for the period 1 January 2004 to 5 October 2009.

The nature of the tendered work covers new construction, refurbishments, additions to existing buildings and fit outs for state schools (including work under the Nation Building Economic Stimulus Plan), TAFEs, health services, ambulance stations, police stations, court houses, residential housing and government office buildings.

All tenders managed by the Department of Public Works represent a value for money outcome for taxpayers.
