

QUESTION ON NOTICE

MR HOPPER asked the Minister for Agriculture, Food and Regional Economies (MR MULHERIN)–

QUESTION:

Will most of the agricultural land at the Dalby Campus of the AACC be sold and if so, when is the sale deadline?

ANSWER:

More than a quarter - 476 hectares - of grazing and cropping land will be retained at the Dalby campus site via agreement with Education Queensland and the Australian Agricultural College Corporation (AACC).

This land will remain accessible to AACC instructional staff for training purposes.

Eleven lots of mixed cropping land totalling 923.5 hectares will be offered for sale by public auction as a whole or individually in July 2011. If all or any of these lots are passed in at auction they will be listed for sale with a reputable real estate agent.

There is no set deadline for the sale of these properties other than what the current real estate market may dictate.
