MR WELLINGTON asked the Deputy Premier, Minister for State Development, Infrastructure and Planning (MR SEENEY) –

QUESTION:

With reference to the Deputy Premier's recent answer to my question about the transparency of the decision making process involving the Caloundra South matter being handed to the Urban Land Development Authority –

Will the Deputy Premier seek agreement from the Leader of the Opposition for the public release of all meeting notes, records of phone conversations and documents not yet in the public domain which led to the former planning Minister and Premier handing planning contract from council to the Urban Land Development Authority?
