764 Review of amendments

- (1) The Minister must review the effectiveness of the amendments of this Act and other legislation made by the *Criminal Law (Coercive Control and Affirmative Consent) and Other Legislation Amendment Act 2023*.
- (2) The review must start as soon as practicable after the end of 3 years after the commencement of this section.
- (3) The review must include a review of the effect on the community of the new offences relating to coercive control and changes to consent, with specific attention to the effect on Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities and multicultural communities.
- (4) As soon as practicable after finishing the review, the Minister must table a report about its outcome in the Legislative Assembly.
