ANNUAL REPORT FOR ASSUMED IDENTITY AUTHORISATION AND USE 2024/2025

<i>(d) a statement about whether or not any fraud or other unlawful activity was identified by an audit under Section 316 of Police Powers and Responsibilities Act (2000);</i>	Audits conducted in accordance with section 316 of the <i>Police Powers and Responsibilities Act 2000</i> did not identify any evidence of fraud or other unlawful activity in relation to the authorities granted during the reporting period.
<i>(e) any other information relating to authorities, assumed identities or the administration of this chapter that the report entity considers appropriate.</i>	Five hundred and seventy-six (576) authorities previously granted under the Act were cancelled during the reporting period as they were no longer required.
