Thank you for your letter of 5 December 2014 concerning petition 2330–14 tabled in the House on 27 November 2014.

I acknowledge the importance of honouring previously unrecognised fallen heroes killed in action during the First World War through a new commemorative precinct and honour board at Yeppoon.

To date, the Queensland Anzac Centenary grants program has committed over \$3.7 million in support of First World War centenary community projects across the State, and I am pleased to confirm that the Yeppoon Centenary of Anzac Commemorative Precinct has been funded to the amount of \$58 522. This allocation was announced on 7 November 2014 as part of round two distribution of grants.

Project organisers have signed grant funding agreements confirming their acceptance of the funding and their commitment to the project.
