I refer to petition 3345-20 lodged with the Legislative Assembly by Mr Mark Boothman MP, Member for Theodore on 11 August 2020 about safety issues on Tamborine–Oxenford Road at the intersections with Michigan Drive and Georgina Street.

I can advise that the intersection of Tamborine–Oxenford Road and Michigan Drive will be considered for funding as part of the next round of the Queensland Government's Safer Roads Sooner (SRS) program. SRS targets minor capital works that aims to improve the safety of the State-controlled road network through the implementation of high-benefit cost-effective safety treatments. The intersection will be prioritised against other locations in Queensland that have been nominated for safety improvements under SRS.

The SRS program is funded under the Queensland Government's Camera Detected Offence Program (CDOP). CDOP covers the management and operation of all modes of camera-based traffic enforcement in Queensland, including the mobile speed camera program, the red light camera program and fixed speed cameras, point to point cameras and combined speed and red light cameras at intersections. All revenue collected by CDOP must by law be used in the administration of CDOP or for limited road safety purposes as defined in legislation.

I trust this information is of assistance.
