I refer to the petition lodged with the Queensland Legislative Assembly on 18 March 2004 by Mr Michael Choi, MP on behalf of residents of the suburb of Alexandra Hills, requesting that the Windemere Road State School site currently held by Education Queensland (EQ) be vested in the local area as parkland.

I am responding to individual petitioners advising them that EQ is in the process of relinquishing this property. The relinquishment process is being undertaken according to the principles as set out in the Government Asset Management System, for which Department of Natural Resources, Mines and Energy is the lead agent. There is an obligation on the part of EQ to proceed under this directive.

The reply also indicates that once the formal relinquishment process had been completed, Redland City Council would have the opportunity to purchase the property under normal commercial processes.
