Dear Mr Winter

Thank you for your e-petition (number 973-07) regarding a referendum to trial daylight saving in Queensland.

As outlined in my response to your previous e-petition in December 2007, the research into daylight saving undertaken by AC Nielsen clearly showed that there continues to be strong opposition to daylight saving from communities in regional and rural areas. It was also clear from the research that the majority of all Queenslanders, including those people living and working in South East Queensland, do not support a split zone system of daylight saving.

The Government continues to consider the research to be conclusive, and does not propose to conduct a referendum or introduce a trial to further gauge public opinion on this matter.
