I refer to e-petition 2760-17 and paper petition 2797-17 lodged with the Legislative Assembly by Mr Michael Crandon MP, Member for Coomera, on 8 and 9 August 2017 about park 'n' ride facilities at Ormeau Station.

The Palaszczuk Government is committed to providing an integrated, efficient and accessible public transport network for Queensland.

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) recognises there is high demand for park 'n' ride facilities across South East Queensland, and it is essential to prioritise investment where it will create the largest positive impact.

In planning for park 'n' rides, TMR assesses the likely impact that a potential park 'n' ride development would have on the transport network, economic development and future land use outcomes.

TMR continually undertakes planning to determine the feasibility of future expansions at park 'n' ride sites across South East Queensland. Any expansion of commuter parking at Ormeau station would be subject to detailed planning, funding availability and statewide prioritisation of infrastructure investments.
