Dear Mr Laurie *Neil,*

I refer to e-petition 2762-17 and paper petition 2799-17 lodged with the Legislative Assembly by Mr Michael Crandon MP, Member for Coomera, on 8 and 9 August 2017 seeking an upgrade to bus services between Ormeau station and Coomera station.

The Palaszczuk Government is committed to providing an integrated, efficient and accessible public transport network for Queensland.

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) acknowledges the growth occurring in the Pimpama area and that the road network continues to mature as new housing estates are being developed. However, the delivery of efficient services in this area is not currently possible, owing to the disconnected road network and lack of bus stop infrastructure.

At this time, patronage levels on existing services in the Pimpama and Coomera area do not warrant additional services.

TMR will continue to work with the City of Gold Coast as development continues in this area, with consideration given to extension of services in the future.
