Dear Mr Laurie

I refer to Petitions 2367–15 and 2453–15, which were tabled on 15 and 16 September 2015 respectively, and note Petitioners' request that the Government fund the construction of an arts and sports hall at Toowoomba State High School's Wilsonton Campus. I also acknowledge previous Petitions 2343–14 and 2384–14 on this matter.

The capital works funding for the 2015–16 financial year has been placed under considerable pressure owing to the previous Government's commitment to funding 10 new schools in South East Queensland under a Public Private Partnership (PPP) model. I must advise petitioners that this decision has contributed to significant financial constraints.

As a result of this decision, approximately one-third of the 2015–16 capital works funding that could be allocated to projects, such as new school halls, must be directed to payments to support PPP schools. The remaining funds will be required to deliver new classrooms to cater for significant growth in student numbers across Queensland.

Although the Government cannot commit to funding this project in the 2015–16 year, I would like to assure your petitioners that the project will be assessed when formulating future capital works programs.
