Thank you for your letter of 6 March 2014 about petition 2227-14.

I am aware of the concerns raised in this petition in relation to the proposed development scheme for the Toondah Harbour Priority Development Area (PDA), and the request for the proposed development scheme to be withdrawn and reviewed in line with community expectations.

The Toondah Harbour PDA was declared at the request of Redland City Council (RCC) on 21 June 2013. The proposed development scheme provides an opportunity to support economic development in Redland City and will seek to reinforce Toondah Harbour as a community hub and a regional gateway to Moreton Bay and North Stradbroke Island. The development will include opportunities for mixed use and medium density residential, tourism and retail based development, dedicated ferry terminals, public open space and the potential for a private berth marina.

The proposed development scheme was publicly notified from 10 January to 24 February 2014. During this period, all interested parties including residents, business operators and community groups were invited to view the proposed development scheme and make a written submission to myself, as Minister for Economic Development Queensland, for consideration. The aforementioned petition has been registered as a submission.

All submissions will be considered, in consultation with RCC, and a submissions report will be prepared identifying the issues, how they have been addressed and what changes have been made to the development scheme.
