Thank you for your letter dated 6 October 2010, forwarding petition number 1411-10. I have considered the petition carefully and am pleased to provide my response.

I note that the petition requests that ENERGEX Limited (ENERGEX) be directed to place underground a section of its proposed Loganlea to Jimboomba 110 kV powerline and that the line should use existing roads.

ENERGEX has requested that the land required for this project be designated for community infrastructure. Ministerial designation of land is a statutory process under the provisions of the *Sustainable Planning Act 2009* (the Act). When making a decision regarding ENERGEX's request, as Minister, I am required to consider a range of matters set down in the Act. This includes being satisfied that adequate environmental assessment has been carried out, that adequate public consultation has occurred and that adequate account has been taken of issues raised during the consultation process.

When deciding whether or not to make the designation, I will consider all issues raised in submissions to ENERGEX and its consultants during the public consultation process, together with ENERGEX's responses to those issues.
