Dear Mr Laurie

I refer to petition number 3079-19 lodged with the Legislative Assembly on 12 February 2019 about safe access to Anzac Avenue, Mango Hill as part of the proposed new local road link from Lamington Road to Anzac Avenue.

The proposed Mango Hill Ring Road Connection is a Moreton Bay Regional Council (MBRC) initiative, involving the creation of a new local road link from Lamington Road to Anzac Avenue, opposite Capestone Boulevard.

Though the Department of Transport and Main Roads has previously provided 'in principle' support to MBRC for this initiative and conceptual designs, it has yet to receive or endorse the detailed designs.

Any request to not install a 'turn left anytime' sign and slipway on the new Lamington Road leg of the future Lamington Road–Anzac Avenue intersection, in favour of a fully signalised intersection, needs to be referred to MBRC for consideration and direct reply.
