I refer to your letter of 20 August 2010 enclosing a copy of Petition No. 1480-10 lodged in the Queensland Legislative Assembly.

The Petition requests that the House make strong representations to the Federal Government and to the Federal Environment Minister to make no further closure of fishing areas until the affected communities concerns are addressed; and that an economic and scientific assessment of the impacts of any closures has been undertaken and publicly released for comment.

The marine park planning in the Hervey Bay region relates to the east marine bioregional planning process being undertaken by the Commonwealth Government. Identifying Areas for Further Assessment (AFFAs) is an early step in this process. Economic and social factors will be key considerations as this planning work progresses.

The Queensland Government has been liaising with the Commonwealth on this issue and will provide input into the planning process where appropriate.
