



## Health and Community Services Committee

### Report on Subordinate Legislation

#### Report No. 4

The Health and Community Services Committee is responsible for examining subordinate legislation within its portfolio areas and considering the policy to be given effect, the application of fundamental legislative principles and the lawfulness of the subordinate legislation (s.93(1) *Parliament of Queensland Act 2001*). The committee's responsibility also includes monitoring the operation of the *Statutory Instruments Act 1992* as it relates to subordinate legislation. The committee reports to the Legislative Assembly approximately quarterly on all subordinate legislation which it considers, and separately where the committee has concerns about consistency with fundamental legislative principles and related issues.

#### **Recommendation**

The committee recommends that the Legislative Assembly note that its Report on Subordinate Legislation, Report No 3, tabled on 9 July 2012, reported incorrectly on the disallowance dates for the subordinate legislation numbers 257, 271, 288, 289, 290, 306, 308 of 2011 and No. 13, 23, and 25 of 2012.

#### **Date for disallowance of subordinate legislation**

The committee's Report No 3 listed the date for disallowance of the following subordinate legislation as 11 July 2012; the correct date for disallowance was 21 June 2012.

In its prior consideration of the subordinate legislation the committee did not identify any significant issues regarding consistency with fundamental legislative principles or the lawfulness of the subordinate legislation.
