		(1) A person exercising control of a place of accommodation must not—
		(a) refuse to accept a reservation or application at the place for accommodation for an accompanied handler because the accompanied handler is accompanied by a guide, hearing, assistance or trainee support dog; or
		(b) refuse to enter into or fulfil an agreement to provide accommodation at the place for an accompanied handler because the accompanied handler is accompanied by a guide, hearing, assistance or trainee support dog; or
		(c) refuse to renew or extend the supply of accommodation for an accompanied handler at the place because the accompanied handler is accompanied by a guide, hearing, assistance or trainee support dog; or
		(d) impose a term as part of an agreement to provide accommodation for an accompanied handler at the place because the accompanied handler is accompanied by a
