I refer to the interim response to petitions 2840-17 and 2848-17 regarding Rosewood station provided by the former Minister for Transport, the Honourable Jackie Trad MP, which was tabled on 13 November 2017.

As you would know, I have now been appointed as Minister for Transport and Main Roads and now provide a final response to the petitions.

The Palaszczuk Government welcomes the opportunity to work with the community to celebrate the 100th anniversary of Rosewood station in 2018 and the role the station has played in Queensland's transport history.

Queensland Rail is proud to have played such a significant role in the Rosewood community over the past century. When Queensland Rail celebrated 150 years of rail in Queensland, it unveiled storyboards at Rosewood station celebrating our rail connections over the years.

The Positive pARTnerships Program at Queensland Rail aims to work with community groups, local schools, and other stakeholders to jointly produce high quality public artwork and instil community pride in rail infrastructure. The Positive pARTnerships team will work with the Rosewood community to develop a community-based art project that represents this significant milestone and instils pride for residents of Rosewood.

In accordance with s 59A of the *Parliament of Queensland Act 2001* and Standing Order 31, I request that this final response be tabled during the period that the Legislative Assembly is dissolved.
