**INTRODUCTION**

On 26 November 2020, the Honourable Shannon Fentiman MP, Attorney-General and Minister for Justice, Minister for Women and Minister for the Prevention of Domestic and Family Violence, introduced the Liquor (Artisan Liquor) Amendment Bill (the Bill) into the Legislative Assembly.

The Bill was subsequently referred to the Legal Affairs and Safety Committee (the Committee) for consideration and report to the Parliament by 12 February 2021.

On 12 February 2021, the Committee tabled Report No. 4 (the report) on the Bill.
