## Erratum to Report No. 21, 57th Parliament – Health Practitioner Regulation National Law and Other Legislation Amendment Bill 2022

The Health and Environment Committee would like to correct an error in the committee's *Report No. 21, 57th Parliament – Health Practitioner Regulation National Law and Other Legislation Amendment Bill 2022,* tabled on 1 July 2022.

Chapter 3 of the report examines the Bill, including evidence concerning the introduction of a proposed power for the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Authority and National Boards to issue interim prohibition orders (IPO) to unregistered practitioners, including practitioners whose registration has lapsed or been suspended.

On page 13, a joint submission from the Australian Medical Professionals' Society (AMPS) and Nurses' Professional Association of Australia is incorrectly listed as being supportive of this amendment in the Health Practitioner Regulation National Law and Other Legislation Amendment Bill.

The committee wishes to clarify that the AMPS does not support the introduction of IPOs to unregistered practitioners set out on page 21 of the joint submission which states the 'AMPS does not support division 7A and recommends it be rejected from the National Law amendments'.
