Dear Mr Laurie

I refer to your correspondence of 15 December 2025 regarding Petition 4275-25 received by the Queensland Legislative Assembly on 10 December 2025.

I appreciate your concerns regarding taking action to reduce hooning in Logan City and referred this matter to the Queensland Police Service (QPS) so that I can be better informed about the issues you have raised.

This Government has committed \$2 million for a network of anti-hooning cameras to be delivered across Rochedale South, Springwood, Daisy Hill, Shailer Park, Mount Cotton, Sheldon and Priestdale. I am informed that the QPS is progressing this commitment. Project scoping has commenced, and the procurement process for the cameras is currently underway. I am advised the QPS is also consulting with relevant stakeholders. The project involves the installation of a network of approximately 40 cameras in designated locations. The Planning Committee has set a completion deadline of 31 December 2027, however delivery is anticipated in 2026.
