I refer to e-Petition 4363-26 tabled in the Legislative Assembly on 10 February 2026 titled *The Federal Government must action a Royal Commission into antisemitism*.

On 9 January 2026, the Governor-General, Her Excellency the Honourable Sam Mostyn AC, issued Letters Patent, which established the Royal Commission on Antisemitism and Social Cohesion. The Honourable Virginia Bell AC SC has been appointed as Royal Commissioner. The Commissioner is required to produce an interim report by 30 April 2026 and a final report by 14 December 2026.

The Letters Patent set out the Royal Commissioner's terms of reference and are available here together with general information about the Royal Commission: <https://asc.royalcommission.gov.au>.

Petitioners may be interested to know that the Crisafulli Government has delivered strong, decisive action to combat antisemitism and hate, and keep guns out of the hands of terrorists and criminals. The reforms in the *Fighting Antisemitism and Keeping Guns out of the Hands of Terrorists and Criminals Amendment Act* represent a zero-tolerance approach to hate, extremism, and intimidation in Queensland, following the devastating Bondi Beach terrorist attack. The new laws introduce tough penalties for the display and use of terrorist symbols and phrases, while delivering stronger protections for places of worship to ensure communities can gather and practise their faith safely.

I thank the petitioners for bringing their concerns to the attention of the House.
