An Act authorising the Treasurer to pay amounts from the consolidated fund for the Legislative Assembly and parliamentary service for the financial years starting 1 July 2014 and 1 July 2015

The Parliament of Queensland enacts—

1 Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Appropriation (Parliament) Act 2014*.

Note—

Under the *Financial Accountability Act 2009*, section 5, words used in this Act that are defined under the *Financial Accountability Act 2009* have the same meaning the words have in that Act, subject to a contrary intention in this Act.

2 Appropriation for 2014–2015

- (1) The Treasurer is authorised to pay \$82 050 000 from the consolidated fund for the Legislative Assembly and parliamentary service for the financial year starting 1 July 2014.
- (2) The amount mentioned in subsection (1) is appropriated for the financial year for the Legislative Assembly and parliamentary service for application to its departmental services, equity adjustment and administered items as stated in schedule 1.
- (3) The amount mentioned in subsection (1) includes the amount already authorised by the *Appropriation (Parliament) Act 2013*, section 3, to be paid for the financial year starting 1 July 2014.

3 Supply for 2015–2016

The Treasurer is authorised to pay \$41 025 000 from the consolidated fund for the Legislative Assembly and parliamentary service for the financial year starting 1 July 2015.

4 Repeal

The Appropriation (Parliament) Act 2012, No. 26 is repealed.
