

COVID-Safe Estimates Hearings 2021

This document applies to any person attending an Estimates Hearing and outlines measures that should be considered during the 2021 Estimates Hearings to ensure they take place in a COVID-Safe way.

It is the responsibility of individuals attending the Hearings to ensure that COVID-Safe practises are adhered to.

It is important to note that over the course of the 2021 Estimates Hearings, restrictions may change in response to the COVID-19 pandemic and all individuals must comply with any new or updated Public Health Directions.

Travel

Including travel between cities and towns across Queensland and travel to and from Hearings

- No one should travel outside of their home if unwell
- Self-isolate if symptoms develop while travelling, get tested, and remain isolated until a negative result is returned
- Maintain physical distancing when travelling – consider alternative seats or rows
- Wear a mask indoors, and outside, where physical distancing is not possible
- Maintain good hand and respiratory hygiene.

Attendance at Hearings

- Do not attend if feeling unwell. Self-isolate, get tested, and remain isolated until a negative result is returned
- Masks must be worn indoors unless necessary for clear communication or if physical distancing can be observed
- Maintain physical distancing where practicable
- Maintain good hand and respiratory hygiene.
 - If taking your mask on and off, consider where you place your mask and whether you need to replace with a new mask
 - When removing your mask, sanitise your hands after removal.
