Attendees will need to pass through security and must provide government issued photo identification (such as a driver licence) as proof of identification before being allowed entry. There may also be delays in entry due to social distancing requirements.

Please enter the meeting room only if there is a sign indicating that the room is 'open to the public'. Please wait outside if you do not see such a sign, as the committee might be discussing something in private, or the schedule might have changed at short notice.

QR Code Visitor Management
