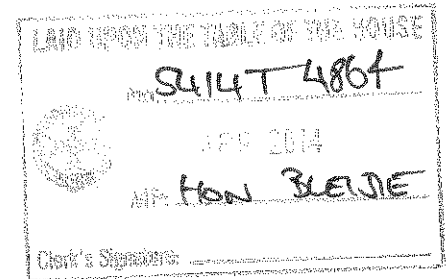

Amendments To Be Moved During Consideration In Detail By The Honourable Jarrod Bleijie MP

Title of the Bill

Work Health and Safety and Other Legislation Amendment Bill 2014 (the Bill).

Objectives of the Amendments

The amendment moved during the consideration in detail of the Bill corrects a drafting error in the penalty provision in Clause 16 to clarify that the penalty under the new section 143A is a WHS civil penalty provision.

Achievement of the Objectives

The objective of this amendment is achieved by amending the penalty provision under the new section 143A, inserted in Clause 16 of the Bill, to be a WHS civil penalty provision.

Alternative Ways of Achieving Policy Objectives

There is no alternative way of achieving the policy objectives.

Consistency with Fundamental Legislative Principles

The amendment is consistent with fundamental legislative principles.
