QUESTION:

With reference to the official commencement of Queensland's fire hazard reduction program 'Operation Cool Burn' last month—

Will the Minister advise when he will be releasing the Inspector-General Emergency Management Report into last year's disastrous fire season?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for the question.

In December 2018, I tasked the Inspector-General Emergency Management to review the effectiveness of preparedness activity and response to the major bushfires that occurred across the State toward the end of 2018.

I have received the report from the Inspector-General which is currently being considered by government. A whole-of-government response will be provided as soon as possible.
