MS ANN LEAHY ASKED THE MINISTER FOR NATURAL RESOURCES, MINES AND ENERGY (HON DR A LYNHAM)—

QUESTION:

With reference to electricity tariffs due to expire in 2020 and 2022—

Will the Minister advise of the number of customers and the names of the customers (reported separately) on the following expiring tariffs, 20, 21, 22, 37, 47, 48, 62, 65, 66?

ANSWER:

The table below sets out the number of individual national meter identifiers (NMI) for businesses in regional Queensland accessing legacy tariffs, as at 14 June 2019 based on data provided by Ergon Energy. Some business customers have multiple NMIs. Ergon Energy is unable to provide the names of the customers associated with these NMIs for privacy reasons.
