Dear Mr Laurie *Neil*

I refer to petition 4233-25, lodged with the Legislative Assembly on 16 September 2025 about reinstating Mount Nebo Road as a state-controlled road.

I can confirm Mount Nebo Road was demained in 1994, when it transitioned from a state-controlled road to a local government road.

Under the *Transport Infrastructure Act 1994*, the Queensland Government applies the following criteria when determining whether a road should be declared as state-controlled:

- the road has national or state significance
- the road links to major centres and regions within the state or adjoining state
- the road is part of the national highway
- the road carries traffic of strategic function or has strategic value from a network perspective and is the most appropriate route for that traffic
- the road provides access to principal terminals of other transport modes, where the terminals are of strategic importance
- state control of the road is essential for economic development of a given region and Queensland as a whole.

While I acknowledge the concerns raised by the petitioners, Mount Nebo Road does not meet the criteria above. As such, the Queensland Government has no plans to reinstate Mount Nebo Road as a state-controlled road. I am advised by the Department of Transport and Main Roads that this information was previously provided to the principal petitioner, Mr Lincoln Hudson, in response to correspondence received in 2020.

It is important to note my department is only responsible for the intersection of Mount Nebo Road with the state-controlled Mount Glorious Road and does not undertake maintenance activities along Mount Nebo Road.
