I refer to Petition 4243-25 (the Petition) tabled in the Legislative Assembly on 30 October 2025 regarding the Parliament's rules about e-petitions.

It is noted that the requirements for e-petitions are outlined in Chapter 21 of the Standing Rules and Orders of the Legislative Assembly (Standing Orders), and that the Petition is seeking an amendment to Standing Orders so that e-petitions on a similar subject matter can be raised simultaneously.

The Committee of the Legislative Assembly (CLA) has responsibility for the oversight of Standing Orders and the practices and procedures of the Legislative Assembly and can make recommendations to the Legislative Assembly about such matters.

Accordingly, I ask that you bring the Petition to the attention of the Speaker of the Legislative Assembly, the Honourable Pat Weir MP, in his role as Chairperson of the CLA, for consideration as he and the CLA may deem appropriate.
