Erratum to Report No. 14, 58th Parliament - Improving Queensland's Container Refund Scheme

The Health, Environment and Innovation Committee seeks to correct the following errors in the committee's Report No. 14, 58th Parliament – Improving Queensland's container refund scheme, tabled on 16 October 2025.

On page 76, the third-last and second-last lines of Table 5, erroneously transposes the network operators for the container refund schemes in the Australian Capital Territory (ACT) and Tasmania. The correct network operator for the ACT is Return-It. The correct network operator for Tasmania is TOMRA Cleanaway.
